

# **SEAS Peer Mentor ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

#### **ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENT**

All current SEASSPAN First Year Mentors, SEASSPAN Undergraduate Ambassadors, and applicants must be fulltime undergraduate students enrolled in the GWU School Engineering and Applied Science (SEAS).

- A SEASSPAN First Year Mentor applicant must be a current first year, sophomore or junior.
- A SEASSPAN Undergraduate Ambassador applicant must be a current sophomore or junior.

### **SERVICE TERM LIMITS**

- SEASSPAN First Year Mentors: A mentor may serve for a maximum of three years and must reapply each year.
- SEASSPAN Undergraduate Ambassadors: An ambassador may serve for a maximum of two years and must reapply each year.

#### STUDENT CONDUCT AND ACADEMIC INTEGRITY

All current SEAS Peer Mentors and applicants must abide by the University's Code of Student Conduct and Code of Academic Integrity.

- All current SEAS Peer Mentors found responsible for any violation of the Code of Conduct and/or the Code of Academic Integrity may face immediate dismissal from the program as determined by the SEAS Dean's Office.
- Any applicant found responsible for any violation of the Code of Conduct and/or the Code of Academic Integrity may be removed from the process by the SEAS Dean's Office.
- Any applicant on disciplinary probation that ends prior to the application deadline is eligible to apply.
- Any applicant who has had a disciplinary record that has been administratively expunged is eligible to apply.
- Any applicant who has a disciplinary record and was found in violation of the Code of Academic Integrity or the Code of Student Conduct but are not currently on disciplinary probation may apply, but is subject to additional review by the SEAS Dean's Office.
- Any applicant with a pending judicial or academic integrity hearing is eligible to apply and may be placed on the waitlist. If the applicant's case is still pending at the end of May, the student will be automatically considered ineligible to serve. If the issue is resolved by the end of May and the applicant is not placed on probation, the applicant may be eligible to serve but may not be offered a position as determined by the Dean's Office.

## ACADEMIC STANDING AND GPA REQUIREMENT

All current SEAS Peer Mentors and applicants must be in good academic standing with the University and must have a semester GPA and/or cumulative GPA of 2.7.

- Any applicant on academic probation that ends prior to the application deadline is eligible to apply.
- All current SEAS Peer Mentors and applicants placed on academic probation during the application process or at any time after being selected may be immediately dismissed from the position or application pool as determined by the Dean's Office.
- All current SEAS Peer Mentors and applicants whose semester or cumulative GPA drops below a 2.7 at any time after becoming a mentor may be immediately dismissed from the position or applicant pool as determined by the Dean's Office.

#### **FINANCIAL STANDING**

All current SEAS Peer Mentors and applicants must be in good financial standing with the University.
